Please find below the presentations of our new projects. As well we would like to point out that our project reports are published in our website.

Village Brabal:

In July 2008 we delivered a medicine bag for a small first aid post. Further information and photos are published in our project report dated 26 th of July 2008 (please choose the section "Our reports" in our website).

In September 2008 we delivered a part (NPR 15.000,00) of the gathered donations for the repair and the reconstruction of the way. Furthermore we helped to organize and coordinate the repair works.

Village Syaphru (landslide):

In August and September 2008 we gathered an amount of NPR 171.048,05 for the landslide victims. After the deduction of NPR 15.000,00 for the way reconstruction in Brabal, we have an amount of NPR 156.048,05 for the affected families in Syaphru.

The official donation delivery will take place after Dashain / Tihar festivities and after permission of the district officer. In the meantime, we will evaluate the actual losses of the concerned victims and will determine the corresponding distribution of the donations.

All further details of the donation distribution and delivery will be published in our new project report as soon as possible.

Child Sponsorship:
