#### Village Syaphru Bensi

#### World Peace Stupa

The Samdheon Woesel World Peace Stupa Construction Committee asked our organization for support in the completion of the world Peace Stupa in Syaphru Bensi. A Stupa is a monument and a symbol for Buddha and the buddhism. The Stupa in Syaphru Bensi is constructed for the peace in the country, in which Lord Buddha was born, for the peace in the world as well as for all living beeings, for the nature and the environment.

The planning of the Stupa has began already in 2005. The construction work is almost finished, currently they are gathering contributions for the purchase and the installation of prayer wheels around the Stupa.

# Village Thulo Shafru

#### <u>Landslide</u>

As soon as the work is finished and the families will provide evidence about the money, which they spent for the reparations, we will deliver the rest of the donations. The costs for reparation and material are approximately NPR 70.000.

#### Shree Nepal Rastriya Lower Secondary School

During our visit in June 2009 we noticed that the most children in Thulo Shafru have only a shoulder bag as a school bag.

Due to the fact, that many of the children have to walk a long distance to school and they have to carry lots of heavy books, we decided to distribute school bagpacks to all students. Thereby costs in an amount of approximately NPR 22,000,-- (calculation based on 110 students) will incure.

# Village Komin:

#### Shree Primary School Komin

In our sustainability report June 2009 we informed already about the fact that the school in Komin announced urgent need of a fence around the school terrain.

Many cows graze on the freely accessible school ground polluting and destroying the terrain. As soon as the fence is generated, the teachers like to plant vegetables and flowers in a school garden. Moreover the children can play undisturbed in nature.

The most reasonable estimate for the construction of a stone fence showed a sum of approximately NPR 200.000,--.

#### Poor families

In Komin, we would like to support some families with blankes and blanket covers. Thereby costs in an amount of (approximately) NPR 22,000, -- (calculation based on 10 families) will incure.

# Village Thulo Barkhu:

#### Poor families

Also in Thulo Barkhu, we would like to deliver blankets and blanket covers to two families. The costs are calculated with approximately NPR 2.400,-- .
